CYD? X STAND OUT UK STREET RULES

TEAM ONLY EVENT SATURDAY 17TH 7.00PM

COMPETITION

- This event is a Team only event
- Minimum of 6 Dancers maximum of 50 Dancers
- This event will be split in to three age categories
 - o 8&Under Open
 - o 12&Under Open
 - o 13+ Open
- Teams may consist of 25% of dancers being older than the age category
- Team Routines can be up to 3minutes
- Teams will dance to their own music.
- Dancers can compete in more than one Team at an additional cost.

AWARDS

- Teams will be placed 1st to 3rd
- Trophies will be awarded 1st to 3rd
- All dancers will receive a certificate for participating.
- The highest scoring Team of the Day will be crowned the CYD? X Stand Out Street Champion and awarded with a Shield
 - o The Team awarded this Shield will hold this title for the year.
 - o The Team will have their Team Name plaque added to the shield and will need to return this trophy for the 2027 Convention
 - o They will also then be given the opportunity to compete at the CYD? X Stand Out UK Street Dance Competition at the Super Convention 2027 to return to battle and keep their title
- Various scholarships prizes and awards will be up for grabs sponsored by CYD?

TEACHERS

- Tickets will need to be reserved by clicking on to the booking form via the CYD? website.
- To Secure your space a £50 deposit per Dance School will be needed, along with estimated Ticket numbers. This will be deducted from your final Invoice.
- We would need to know roughly how many dancers are also attending.
- Final Ticket Numbers are needed 6 weeks prior to the event.

- After this date an Invoice will be sent and payment must be made within one week.
- Once a deposit has been received, teachers will receive an entry form where we will need all dancers' names and dates of birth who will be competing in the competition.
- This form will need to be returned 6 weeks prior to the event.

TICKETS AND PRICING

- One Day Entry Ticket CYD? - £28.50 per person
 - o This ticket allows entry in to the event ONLY
- Stand Out UK Competition Ticket - £12 per dancer
 - o This allows the dancer to compete in one Team event.
 - o If a dancer is competing in more than one team it's an additional £12 per entry.
 - o No additional charge for spectators. Just the CYD? entry fee of £28.50
- Workshops – CYD? Super Convention will have over 200 workshops for dancers to choose from along with a Special Stand Out UK Workshop. These will go on sale in June and will need to be booked through the CYD? Website on a first come first serve basis at an additional cost from £8.50 per workshop

JUDGE CRITERIA

Teams are judged on the following criteria

SCORING MAX POINTS	SCORING MAX POINTS
Musicality -Transitional Movements between Tracks, how well the music goes to the style of dance.	10
Formation and Spacing -The more Formations and Transitions the higher the score. -Spacing and Placement are very important, levels and use of stage/ space	10
Originality, Creativity and Performance -No clear dances copied from social media. - Presentation, Costumes and how well the dancers perform their set. -Projection and Energy of their Performance	10
Choreography and Execution -How well the piece has been choreographed.	10

<p>Styles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Hip Hop -Breaking -House -Locking -Popping -Waacking -Krump -Voguing. -DanceHall - Afro <p>-Knowledge of the styles delivered is important and that they are executed correctly, and as we feel styles are important, we also don't want this to be an aspect of the dance therefore we feel you must only incorporate a minimum of 2 styles.</p> <p>-We need to see two continuous counts of 8 for the style to count</p>	<p>10</p>
<p>Deductions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use of foul language -Loss of clothing (etc - hat) -Music running over the specific time -Falls or Drops will be deducted. -Inappropriate Dance Moves Music and Costume -Clear mistakes 	<p>5</p>

All judges will score on a score sheet that will be sent via text to the dance teacher/school at the end of the day. If not by the end of the day by the Wednesday after the event at the very latest.

- Scored 1-10 – 1 being the lowest and 10 being the highest
 - 1-3 below Average
 - 3-5 Average
 - 5-7 Good
 - 7-8 Very Good
 - 9-10 Excellent

Judge A will be the head judge for any rule breaks within the Team
